

This is a suggested supply list for the 2017-18 school year. Your child will be using these supplies greatly throughout the year. Your help in supplying your child with these supplies is greatly appreciated. Please bring the following supplies to your classroom during the first week of school.

- 5 Plastic folders-pockets on the bottom, various SOLID colors → labeled with name
- 1 Homework folder-pockets on the bottom & labeled with name
- 4 Marble composition notebooks- <u>WIDE RULED 4 labeled with name</u>
 (if possible, different colors)
- 5 Jumbo Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pair of children's scissors-labeled with name
- 1 box of Crayons—No more than 24
- 1 pkg. of colored pencils-No more than 12
- 8 large erasers & pencil top erasers
 - 36 **SHARPENED** Ticonderoga pencils

- 3 boxes of #2 pencils (Not Mechanical)


Erasers

- Folders 1 Yellow (Writing), purple (Reading), green (Math), blue (Science), red (Social Studies), 2 choice (Take-Home and World Language)

Total = 8 folders

❖ Book Covers - 1 purple jumbo sized (Reading), 1 of your choice (Health)

Total = 2 book covers
